Bainbridge Island, Seattle, Washington, USA by Joel Pritchard, Barney McCallum & Bill Bell

Pickleball grows in the Pacific Northwest region

1975

The National Observer published an article about pickleball

1984 U.S.A.P.A formed.

2002

The first **National Championships** were hosted by the Villages, Florida

2011-2019

Pickleball clubs setup in the UK, Spain, China, Thailand, Japan, Finland, Holland, France and many other countries. Tournaments were set up in Europe: Spain, UK, Holland, Finland, Italy, Germany, France, to name a few. Southern Hemisphere also introduced tournaments - India, Singapore, Thailand. Australia, Taiwan.

2016

First Issue of **Pickleball Magazine** was published Jan 2016.

2019

APP Tour launched first USA sanctioned tour for professionals and amateurs; Pickleball Tournaments.com listed 748 tournaments!

2022

Pickleball became the Official Sport of Washington State when SB5615 was passed.

Pickleball accepted as an exhibition sport at the **World Maccabi Games**

2024

1st European Championships held with 24 participating countries. England won.
